

5th Annual Buck\$ By De\$ign

Elite Pre-Futurity & Bucking Genetic Sale

Consignment Guidelines

1. Each consignor will be limited to 3 cattle consignments and 3 pre-futurity consignments
2. Potential consignors will be required to nominate potential cattle they want to sale and provide video. Buck\$ By De\$ign will review nominations and select a limited number of elite cattle to be sold. Once the cattle are reviewed, all potential consignors will be notified of the acceptance of their cattle or the pre-paid fees will be returned if the cattle are not accepted. Once the cattle are accepted, there will be no substitution or cancellation of consignment without loss of pre-paid fees.
3. All cattle consigned must be registered through the American Bucking Bull, Inc. (ABBI), and all pre-futurity bulls must have both registered parents (sire and dam). A copy of the registration papers must be received along with nomination forms no later than August 17, 2007. *If the copy is not received by August 17, 2007, all pre-paid fees will be forfeited and cattle will not be sold at sale.*
4. All cattle accepted must be checked in on September 28, 2007 between 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** No late arrivals will be accepted and all pre-paid fees will be forfeited on late arrivals and/or on no arrivals.
5. Sellers will be responsible for cattle up until the time the auctioneer declares the animal sold. Buck\$ By De\$ign, it's associates and/or affiliates will not be responsible for any loses due to injury, sickness or death to the animal.
6. All disputes will be between the buyer and the seller. Seller agrees to refund sales price to buyer if it is proven that the animal is not as seller guaranteed animal to be (ex: not bred, genetics do not match guarantees, etc.). If it is necessary to give a refund, buyer will arrange to have animal returned to the seller at seller's expense.
7. There will be a licensed veterinarian on-site at the RFD filming session (September 1 & 2, 2007) to age certify pre-futurity bulls purchased at buyer's expense (unless seller no sales the bull. In that case seller will be charged \$50.00). *The seller will forfeit all pre-paid fees if the pre-futurity bull does not qualify for sale after age certification.* The veterinarian will also palpate all females at the RFD filming session. This expense will also be a buyers expense.
8. The Super Saturday Sale will be broadcast nationwide. Each consignor will have the OPTION of paying an additional \$150 broadcast fee to allow people across the U. S. to see and bid on their lot over the TV. The cattle will also be required to be brought to RFD-TV filming day to be held September 1-2, 2007 at Buck\$ By De\$ign Ranch in Orchard, TX.
